**This 1863 “Steamboat Gothic” home, constructed from local redwood trees, is on the National Register of Historic Places and is one of the oldest structures in San Mateo County. Located near the corner of Marshall and Hamilton Streets, across the street from the San Mateo County Courthouse, will have Docents on hand to give tours and information. There is no fee to tour Lathrop House, but donations are appreciated. The house is operated by the Redwood City Heritage Association volunteers and is totally supported by donations. There is also an on-site collectible shop, Tarnished Doorknobs, operated by the Redwood City Heritage Association.**
